Led by Archduke Nathan Kilmer, they must work to unite a divided Earth overcome with political turmoil, corporate corruption and global strife, all while preparing for the impending attack of an alien race of barbaric conquerors, The Dvora.

SYNOPSIS

A cinematic grounded sci fi series that follows political and real-world consequences, when an armada of extraterrestrial spaceships arrive on earth in the year 2048. The occupants turn out not to be aliens, but humans that were abducted 20 years earlier.

Calling themselves The Tutatori, they are led by "Archduke" Nathan Kilmer. A former history teacher, who no longer teaches history, but creates it with every decision he makes. Nathan claims, a friendly race of aliens, the Ylatchee took them from Earth, trained them, gave them their technology and have sent them back with an offer and a warningThe Dvora are coming.

The Dvora, barbaric conquerors are 10 years away and if they find an unprotected Earth, they will enslave humanity and strip the Earth bare of its resources. Leaving a dead world after consuming everything in KuLather " The Great Feast". Nathan along with the other leaders of the Tutatori, must convince the people of Earth that in order to be saved from The Dvora, they must join the Empire.

While the leaders and citizens of Earth decide on the offer, Nathan and the rest of the Tutatori discover and confront a Dvora scout fleet, signaling they are much closer than they thought.

THE YLATCHEE IMPERIUM

THE SPECIES

The Ylatchee Imperium is comprised of 6 Species; The Ylatchee, The Agi, The Micor, The Xolden, The Ukak & The Olani .

SOCIETY

The Imperium have an intricate imperial representative democratic political system. Ruled by an Emperor, who is chosen for life via ducal council of "Archduke". Each species is governed by an "Archduke" who is chosen via ducal council of "Dukes" who oversee territories on their home worlds, any species can become Emperor. Like the United States, The Imperium have a similar "Bill of Rights" bestowed to all it's citizens. While many of the laws of The Imperium are similar, they look at corruption more stringent with the sets of anti-corruption laws the most with the ability to set the harsh rulings . Capital punishment is carried out under Imperium Law.



THE DVORA

PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Dvora are large creatures mostly resembling Hyenas. They stand on hind legs, with only a very stubby tail (or none) and are always tall enough to 'loom' when in company of other species. They speak only in their native tongues and use computerized translators to communicate with species other than their own.

SOCIETY

The Dvora operate mostly with a pack mentality. The only time they will be found alone is when they are scouting – either in space or on a planet. Little is known about their society structure except they have leaders called 'hunter', 'lead hunter', and 'great hunter'. They conquer planets, preferably with societies that have just begun space flight and are industrialized.

They occupy several conquered planets for generations until that planet's resources are nearly used up and then they move on to other likely targets. When they leave a planet, they 'finish off' the original species in a great feast.



EPISODE CONCEPTS

EPISODE 1: "PILOT"

Lance Rogers, the 1st reporter in space is returning to Earth on the newest United States Space Shuttle, after a contentious 15-day mission. As the shuttle returns to Earth, it collides with a cloaked Alien spaceship and is heavily damaged. The ship communicates in perfect English and offers to tow the Shuttle to its Flagship once it arrives with their armada. Once on the flagship Lance and the Crew are introduced to their leader Nathan Kilmer, who informs them that everyone on the 600 ships, over 130,000 people are humans and they have returned to Earth with an offer and a warning, the Dvora are coming, and they are Earth's only hope.

EPISODE 2: "THE RETURNED"

Archduke Nathan Kilmer arrives earth side to present the invitation from the Empire to the UN. Nathan's backstory is told as well as the previous events leading up to the arrival. Amelia's leadership is questioned when she struggles to bring Lance to their side. Lance starts seeing Angela. Nathan reveals the Empire's offer; join the Empire gain a fighting chance against the Dvora or if you decline, the Tutatori leave taking with them, their ships and Technology knowing they will be the last of humanity.

EPISODE 3: "INVITATION"

The World leaders deliver a resounding rejection of the invitation and demand the Tutatori turn over their ships and submit themselves to the authority of Earth's governments or leave. Lance chooses Nathan and the Tutatori over his mother. A power dynamic of The Board is upended.

EPISODE 4: "LINES IN THE SAND"

The Liberian President sends word that if the Tutatori are serious about helping, they are willing to accept their assistance and will vote to join the Empire. The Major governments of Earth threaten that if the Tutatori enter from orbit into any country's air space, they will be met with force.

EPISODE 5: "TO NEW BEGININGS"

Katerina reaches a deal with Liberia to assist their people. She personally oversees the creation of the first enclave in Liberia. Lance arrives with the relief mission to the enclave with Angela. They assist in delivering food and medical supplies. To create backlash against Tutatori "brutality", Russian, Chinese & US Aircraft Carriers strike the Liberian enclave and attack the fleet in orbit. In the confusion of the attack, mercenaries attack the enclave and kidnap Lance and Katerina.

EPISODE 6 "HEART"

Tutatori Security officer Hasid Al-Karuq leads the search for Lance and Katerina. Amelia Rogers publicly blames Tutatori for her son's situation and tries to create a negative public reaction against Tutatori after Lance is shot during the rescue attempt when security forces catch up to the Mercenaries. Lance is saved and sent home with Angela; their relationship grows stronger. When his mother comes to visit him, he confronts her about her involvement. She denies and attempts to convince him to distort what the Tutatori are doing.

EPISODE 7: "THE PRICE "

Angela is murdered, Lance finds out she was pregnant. He blames his mother and cuts off relations with her. Facing a boycott of all Tutatori technology to countries that assisted in the abduction, The US China & Russia turn over businessmen whom they claim were reasonable. They are tried in accordance with Imperial law and sentenced to death, which turns public opinion against the Tutatori.

EPISODE 8: "THE DVORA "

Lance dives deeper into work after the murder of Angela. A Tutatori scout ship 12.2 Light years away approaches planet and discovers it has been destroyed. They begin to investigate how it was destroyed.

FUTURE SEASONS

SEASON 1

The first season will explore the Tutatori, who they were and experiences that shaped them. Discover their goals and their mission to save Earth. How they deal with the conflicts at the global, national, and personal level as their technology begins to reach into the everyday societies. The backstory of the major characters will be told. A campaign of misinformation is started against the Tutatori in hope of swaying popular opinion to consider Nathan's proposal.

SEASON 2

Season two would pick up one year after the arrival. Graduation ceremony of the first batch of recruits to join the Tutatori after their arrival, the events are marred by terrorist bombing. Season two would highlight the new values, beliefs, and thoughts spreading throughout the world, mostly third world countries would be the primary nations embracing the Tutatori and receiving the new tech, advancing to and in some cases past the current superpower. The members of the Tutatori also must adjust to once again being home, on Earth; facing their families and friends they've left behind. They are now dealing with a new threat Religious extremist. In the on-going search for the Dvora continues, by the end of season two they realize they are much closer to discovering Earth and arriving sooner than expected.

SEASON 3

Season three would deal with the ramification of season two's cliffhanger, creating forced collaboration between the major countries that have been so against the Tutatori. As the advance technology becomes accessible, problems arise from the Technology getting out. Continuation of backstory of both major and minor characters from their time training. Season three would dive into the mysterious Ylatchee empire and beginnings of the war between the Ylatchee and Dvora. A small faction of Tutatori members become disillusioned and commit to if necessary, forcing Earth to join the empire.



TONE

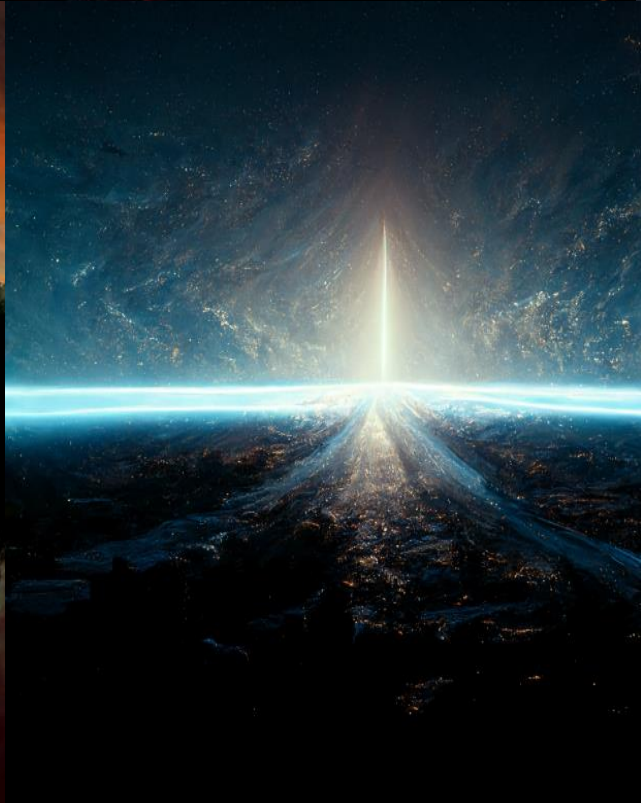
Set in the year 2048 and the re-imagined past, the series will be grounded in the real world, showcasing an even more divided corporate driven political system.
